- 2. Once you have identified the work, you will give a 8-10 minute oral presentation:
 - Describe the work. Be sure to include a brief discussion of the genre, the artist/s as well as its history
 - Discuss the meaning of the work. Why was it written? Consider analyzing the lyrics, if any.
 - How and why does this music speak to you? What is the significance of the selected work as it relates to your identity and experience?
